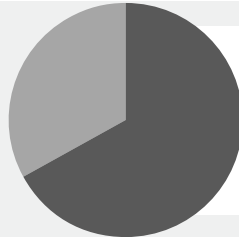


Our students have launched 5 payloads into space in the last 5 years!

This report ranks 4,500 colleges and universities by return on investment titled, "A First Try at ROI: Ranking 4,500 Colleges." Capitol Technology University was ranked 213 out of 4,500 with a 20 year NPV, ranked 141 out of 4,500 after a 30 year NPV, and over a 40 year lifetime of work, ranked 120 out of 4,500 colleges/universities.
