What to Bring:

Bedding & Linens:

- Extra-long twin bed sheets (80in) or standard twin size (75in) if applicable
- Pillows, Blankets, and a Comforter
- Mattress pad for add comfort

Personal Items:

- Clothing & medications
- Alarm clock
- Robe and slippers
- Headphones/earbuds
- Hangers
- Flashlights
- Laundry supplies
- Pictures/Posters
- Rain/Snow Gear
- Bookbag & desk/school supplies
- Iron w/ Automatic Shutoff
- Key chain
- Address book, envelopes, stamps
- Calendar
- Sports Equipment

Bathroom:

- Shower tote
- Shower curtain/liner (1 per bathroom)
- Toiletries and toilet paper
- Towels and shower shoes/flip flops for bathroom
- Cleaning supplies
- Personal hygiene items

Kitchen:

- Dishes, utensils (flatware), pots and pans
- Dish soap, sponge, dishwasher detergent, trash can (can't exceed 13 gallons)
- Microwaves (1000 watts limit), Air Fryers, Blenders are permitted

Electronics/Tech Equipment:

- Laptops, TVs, gaming consoles, batteries
- Small fan, study light, extension cord

Don't Forget...

Prescriptions, List of Important Phone Numbers, Batteries, Suntan Lotion, Calculator, Books, TV, First Aid Kit, Groceries, Can Opener

Because of the special nature of the Residence Hall community, the following items are **PROHIBITED:**

- Pets (except non-meat-eating fish)
- Candles and Incense
- Space Heaters
- Amplifiers and Large Speakers
- Kegs, Beerballs, or Taps
- Firearms or other weapons (including splatball and BB guns)

Reminders:

- Extension cords used in rooms and appliances used in kitchens should be U.L. approved. U.L. approved power strings with fuses or circuit breakers are encouraged.
- Each room is furnished with a window covering.
- All carpet and furniture brought into the residence hall must be in good condition. In addition, the furniture assigned to your room must remain in your room. We cannot store any room furniture for students.
- **Residence Hall-size refrigerators** (less than 5 cubic feet) are allowed in the rooms.
- **Kitchen Cabinet space for larger occupant apartments may run out fast, additional shelving is allowed!**
