



Cleaning Policy

- Disinfectants
 - The university will use disinfectants which meet EPA criteria for use against SARS-CoV-2, the virus that causes COVID-19 and appear on the EPA's List N.
- Class Schedule
 - Classes have been scheduled with a 30 minute break between classes. All classrooms used for classes will be disinfected during the scheduled breaks. The classrooms will have a log for cleaning staff to note date, time and initials after cleaning. Facilities management personnel will review room logs twice a day.
 - Classrooms that are not scheduled for classes are unavailable unless reserved. Any classroom used for this purpose will be disinfected before a subsequent use. Log for cleaning staff to note date, time and initials after cleaning. Facilities management personnel will review logs daily.
- Common areas
 - Common areas, such as Student Center, Library and hallways, will be disinfected twice a day. Facilities management personnel will review logs daily.
- Bathrooms
 - Bathrooms will be cleaned and disinfected every 3 hours. The rooms will have a log for cleaning staff to note date, time and initials after cleaning. Facilities management personnel will review room logs twice a day.
- Innovators Hall
 - Common areas, lobbies, mailboxes, and elevators will be disinfected twice a day. The university will provide every apartment with disinfectants for use in shared spaces (kitchens, bathrooms, and living rooms). The university will provide clear and detailed instructions for students to use disinfectants properly within they apartment.
- Offices
 - Administrative and faculty offices will be cleaned and disinfected every evening. Facilities management personnel will review logs daily.
