(KASA)
CONSTITUTION

Article I: Name

The organization's name shall be the Kerbal Aeronautics and Space Administration, or KASA for short.

Article II: Purpose

KASA's purpose is to bring together many Kerbal Space Program fanatics and compete in various competitions or work collaboratively in joint missions on KASA's server.

Article III: Membership

Section 1. Eligibility

Any of Capitol College's undergraduate students are eligible for membership

Section 2. Attendance

All members are encouraged to attend weekly. If a member decides not to attend a certain meeting, there will be no reciprocation.

Article IV: Officers and Selection

Section 1. Officer Responsibilities

- A. President
 - a. Approve various mods proposed via the Mod Proposal Process (SEE Article V, Section 3).
 - b. Be responsible for deciding the activities conducted at weekly meetings.
 - c. Approve the Weekly Challenges, if any.

- B. Vice-President
 - a. Stand in the President's position when the President cannot.
 - b. Carry out any tasks delegated by the president.
- C. Secretary
 - a. Maintain KASA's main server.
 - b. Send out group emails when necessary.
- D. Treasurer
 - a. Manage any monetary issues, if they occur.
- E. Club Advisor
 - a. Oversee the activities of the club.
 - b. The club advisor has the right to veto any decision made by the club if the decision may directly cause catastrophic results

Section 2. Selection of Leadership

- A. Selection Process
 - a. The club will have voting done at the beginning of every academic year by at least the end of September.
 - b. All members, including club officers, but excluding the advisor will vote for each position.
 - c. Any persons are eligible to run for any office position excluding advisor, can submit their name on the ballot by notifying the current president.
 - d. In case of a tie, the club advisor will make the final decision.
 - e. The Club Advisor holds the right to refuse any person of office position and ask for a re-vote.

Article V: Kerbal Space Program Modifications

Section 1. List of Approved Mods

- A. A list of approved mods will be maintained as a PDF document in the club's MyCapitol Portal.

Section 2. Proposal to Add/Remove Mod from list

- A. Any member may propose that a mod be added or removed from the list. That member is required to have another club member co-sponsor their proposal.

- B. The proposal may be submitted via email to the club president for consideration. This email must be submitted by at least two members of the club for consideration.

Section 3. Mod Addition/Removal Process

- A. Once the president has received notification by email from two club members regarding the same issue, the president shall hold a club wide polling via whatever means necessary.
- B. The poll must be finalized no later than one week from the initiation of the poll.
- C. All club members are allowed to vote except for the club president and club advisor.
- D. The majority opinion will stand in the case of the proposal.
- E. If there is a tie, the club president makes the final decision.

Section 4. Using Mods not on the approved list

- A. Members may NOT use any mods that are not on the approved list while connected to KASA's server.
- B. Members may use non-approved mods on their own machines privately, but not as a part of this club.

Article VI: Impeachment

- A. At any time during an officer's term, the club may elect to impeach the current officer and hold re-elections.
- B. To impeach the officer, the club will hold a club-wide poll with all student leadership voting as well. The vote must be at least two thirds of the club for the impeachment to carry.
- C. Like before, the club advisor holds the right to veto any impeachment if the advisor finds it unnecessary.
- D. If an officer is impeached, an interim officer may be appointed by the club president or, in the case of a presidential impeachment, the club advisor. This officer may only hold the interim position for 1 month before a re-election must be held.

Article VII: Amendments

- A. An amendment can be made to this constitution at any time during the academic school year.

- B. The Amendment Process:
 - a. An amendment must be proposed in writing to the club president with at least one other co-sponsor for it to be considered.
 - b. At that time, the president must hold a club wide vote, including all officers, excluding the advisor, for the case of the amendment.
 - c. In order for the amendment to be added to the club's constitution, the vote must come in favor for at least two thirds of the club.
 - d. At that time, the amendment shall be added to the constitution and the document must be immediately updated.

Article IX: Ratification
