

COVID-19 HOUSING REGISTRY

FOR RESIDENTIAL STUDENTS

Those students who made the decision to return to campus after Reading Days will receive a refund for 3 weeks of housing, provided they vacate the building by **Sunday, April 5**.

Students who intend to remain in the building after April 5 must resubmit a registry to remain on campus.

The registry will be considered a request to stay and will be reviewed by a panel of campus staff. Students requesting to stay due to work obligations must provide documentation from a supervisor. Students requesting to stay because they do not have Internet service at home must provide a letter from a parent or guardian. Students who live out of state or who have no other place to go do not need to provide documentation.

The form and documentation must be emailed to studentlife@captechu.edu by April 3. Requests will receive an approval or denial by Tuesday, April 8.
